The National Youth Agency Youth Report Card summarises – on one sheet of paper – local performance on 25 National Indicators directly relevant to young people. It is a valuable and powerful tool developed with the input of local authorities to enable them to measure their performance against national benchmarks. The card is free to each local authority on request.

Key features include:

- a one-page summary of local performance
- a tool to aid local authorities, including elected members
- highlighting good performance and areas for improvement
- an indication of overall direction for the local authority.

The Youth Report Card builds on the extensive work the National Youth Agency has carried out over many years on auditing local authority youth services and improving performance in the youth sector.
